



EXTERNAL COACHING POLICY (2022)

External coaches wishing to conduct business within an iFLY Canada wind tunnel agrees to -

- Follow proper IBA protocols up to and including, but not limited to:
 - maintaining the proper ratings
 - Following all existing IBA policies as well as any future amendments or new changes set forth by the IBA
- Communicate his(her) professional liability insurance policy (1) to be approved by iFLY Canada prior to commencement of coaching services
- Declare his(her) professional activity to tax administration(s)
- Communicate his(her) company registration number if he/she achieves more than \$30k in annual turnover
- Follow all existing safety protocols/policies set forth by iFLY and the IBA, acknowledging that these protocols/policies are constantly evaluated and may change at any time
- Respect the authority and decisions of iFLY employees at any time

The coach is informed that iFLY will report the professional activities to the provincial tax administration.

This agreement is valid for the current calendar year. It shall be renewed each year. It may be updated or revoked unilaterally by iFLY Canada with or without notice.
